



Skills for Labour Markets in the Digital and Green Transition

SkiLMeeT, a three-year project funded by Horizon Europe, aims to advance policy-relevant research that will help leverage the opportunities of the digital and green transition and equip the European workforce with the skills required for the future of work.

SkiLMeeT explores how the digital and green transition is reshaping the demand for skills. We will analyse in detail:

- the extent of skills shortages and mismatches
- the drivers of skills gaps
- strategies to close the skills gaps, including re- and upskilling initiatives



Our project conducts quantitative and qualitative research using innovative data and methods. Throughout the research process, we engage with stakeholders such as trade unions, employers' organisations, and NGOs to ensure that our approach and recommendations are relevant and responsive to the needs of practitioners shaping skills policies.
